Alfred “Al” Anthony Gaeta, age 53 of Plattsmouth, NE unexpectedly passed away on Thursday, January 4, 2024.

Al was born on March 20, 1970 to Robert “Bob” Joseph Gaeta and Dolores “Dee” Ann (Reinig) Gaeta in Omaha, NE. He graduated from Millard South High School in 1988. After graduation he attended the University of Nebraska at Kearney for a year. He then went on to obtain his pilot’s license in Colorado Springs, CO. After that he moved to New York City and received his training as an airline flight dispatcher. He worked for Air Wisconsin, a regional airline for United, in Appleton, WI for ten years. In 2005 he moved back to Omaha and he worked for Werner Enterprises as a dispatcher.
