Alfred “Fred” Joseph LeBreton Jr. age 83 of Plattsmouth, NE peacefully passed away on Thursday, October 28, 2021 at the Lancaster Rehabilitation Center in Lincoln, NE.

Fred was born on March 13, 1938 to Alfred Joseph Sr. and Stella (Houle) LeBreton in Spencer, MA. He grew up in Worcester, MA which is 44 miles from the east coast. He had five siblings Shirley, Nancy, Richard, Barbara, and Gary.

When Fred was eighteen years old, he enlisted the U.S. Air Force and he proudly served his country for twenty years. Fred mostly worked at the Strategic Air Command Headquarters on Offutt Air Force Base in Bellevue, NE for the majority of his career.
