Anthony "Tony" John Rotundo age 83 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away peacefully on May 20, 2015 at the Bellevue Medical Center in Bellevue, NE. Tony was born on June 27, 1931 to Anthony George and Mary Anna (Buynak) Rotundo in Cleveland, OH. He was raised and educated in Cleveland and graduated from high school with the class of 1949. Tony enlisted in the US Air Force in 1951, serving his country for twenty one years, during the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War. He and his family lived in several different locations, while he was in the Air Force, finally settling in Omaha, NE. Tony retired from the Air Force as a Personnel Specialist in 1973. Then, he worked for the US Postal Service in Omaha for thirteen years. In 1999, Tony and Shirley moved into their dream home in Buccaneer Bay, NE and they have been there since.

He was a member of the Church of the Holy Spirit, Lepert Wolever V.F.W. Post #2543, and Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie #365 all of Plattsmouth.
