Arline Alice (Clum) Anderson age 82 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Sunday, March 27, 2022 at the Bellevue Medical Center in Bellevue, NE. Arline was born on May 28, 1939 to Arthur B. and Helen Isabelle (Brainard) Clum in Roxbury, NY. She attended and graduated from Walton Central High School in Walton, NY. She attended the University of New York at Oneonta, Southeastern Community College, and Bellevue University earning her Bachelor's Degree in Business. Arline moved to Nebraska in October of 1963. She worked for the Civil Service for 27 years, retiring from U.S. Stratcom in 2004. She also worked as a para educator and substitute teacher for the Plattsmouth Elementary Schools for eleven years.

Red". She loved golfing and hiking and she enjoyed exercising and working out to stay in shape. She loved to travel when she was able and Arline loved glamping in her "Lil Red" Glamper, at least before a flood took her away. She is survived by her three sons: Christopher Risk and his wife Rebecca of Albuquerque, NM; Timothy Risk and his wife Herdie of Omaha, NE; Joey Risk and his wife Michelle Kearney, NE; four grandchildren: Zakery, Kazden, Sunday, and Samuel Risk; one great granddaughter: Lucy Risk; and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and countless friends.
