Barbara Louise Shaffer age 72 of Plattsmouth, NE formerly of Omaha, NE passed away on Sunday, June 3, 2018 at The Nebraska Masonic Home in Plattsmouth.

Barb owned the original DeLice Bakery in the Old Market and was the originator and publisher of The Old Market Encounter Magazine. Barb was also a long-time member of Connections, a support group of professional women.
