Cecile Marie (Killeen) Hoppe age 100 of Louisville, NE formerly of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Monday, July 4, 2016 at the Louisville Care Center.

She was born on January 3, 1916 to James Michael and Cecile Lovella (Campbell) Hoppe in North Bend, NE. Cecile was raised and schooled in North Bend until 1928, when at twelve years old she moved with her family to Cedar Rapids, NE. Cecile graduated from St. Anthony's High School in Cedar Rapids with the class of 1933. While in high school she met Louis "Lou" Aronson Hoppe and they were later married on April 20, 1936 at St. Anthony's Church in Cedar Rapids. Cecile and Lou made their home in Cedar Rapids for three years and then they moved to Omaha. She had worked at 9 Cents Cleaners and then Cecile helped Lou with his construction company. In 1963, Cecile and Lou moved to Plattsmouth and where they owned and operated Hoppe Paint Company until they retired in 1988. Then in 2011 they moved to Louisville, due to Lou's failing health.

Cecile was a member of Church of The Holy Spirit in Plattsmouth and the Catholic Daughters both of Plattsmouth, NE.
