David Francis Feder Sr. age 72 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Monday, June 2, 2014 at the Bellevue Medical Center Bellevue, NE.

David was born on August 29, 1941 to Charles Francis and Mary Dorothy (Novak) Feder in Omaha, NE. He was raised and schooled in Omaha and graduated from South High School with the class of 1959. After graduating from high school, he enlisted in the US Navy serving his country on the USS Hornet for two years. After serving in the Navy, he returned to Omaha and worked at the Stockyards and Western Electric. He attended night school at the University of Nebraska at Omaha and graduated with an Associates of Fire Science Degree. Then David worked as a Fire Apparatus Engineer for the Omaha Fire Department for thirty years, until he retired in 1999. He met Linda Rae Kindelin and they were later married on July 7, 1979 in Plattsmouth, NE. After marrying Linda he moved to Plattsmouth in 1979. After retiring from the Omaha Fire Department, he worked for Wiles Brothers for ten years and then at B & T Murdochs for four years.

David was a member of Hosanna Lutheran Church, Lepert Wolever V.F.W. Post #2543, Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie #365 all of Plattsmouth, Firefighters Helmet Club of Omaha, and the Tuesday Art Club.
