Doris Laura (Perkins) Kimball age 95 of Omaha, NE passed away peacefully on Saturday, July 18, 2015 at the Good Samaritan Society – Millard in Omaha. Doris Laura (Perkins) Kimball was born on December 11, 1919 to Fredrick Elia and Ada Violet (Williams) Perkins in Precept, NE. She was raised in rural Beaver City and attended school at the Platte Valley Academy (K-12) in North Platte, NE. After graduating from high school, she attended a secretarial school in North Platte, NE for one year. She met George William Kimball Jr. and they were later married on May 12, 1941 in Detroit, MI. Doris and George made their home in Detroit and later moved to Louisiana until WWII began. Doris moved to Hastings, NE to live with George's parents, George Sr. and Bessie Kimball, while George was stationed in Europe with the US Army. After George returned from the war, Doris and George moved into their own home in Hastings, where their children George III and Diane were born. They lived in Hastings until 1963, when they moved to Kearney, NE. Then in 1973 they moved to Omaha, NE and have been there since. Doris was a wife, stay at home mom, homemaker, and a loving grandmother. She was a member of the Kearney Hospital Service League and served as an officer for many years.

She is survived by her daughter: Diane Ulrich and husband Fred of Louisville, NE, one daughter-in-law: Joan Hansberry of Bellingham, WA, four
