Ernest "Jerry" Gerald Stump age 75 of Beaver Lake, NE passed away on Thursday, December 8, 2022 at his residence.

Jerry was born on April 25, 1947 to Ernest Frederick Stump and Vera Mae (Jordan) Stump in Omaha, NE. He was raised and schooled in Omaha and he attended South High School. Jerry enlisted in the U.S. Navy and he proudly served his country during the Vietnam War. After serving his country, Jerry returned to Omaha and worked at General Electric and later for the City of Omaha at the Missouri River Plant and the Papio Water Treatment Plant. He met the love of his life Carol Ann Bailey and they were later married on January 3, 1967 in South Omaha. Jerry and Carol made their home and raised their daughter in South Omaha until they moved to Beaver Lake in 1984.

Jerry was a member of Disabled American Veterans General Mac Arthur Chapter #2 of Omaha, American Legion Post #331 South Omaha, and VFW Post #10727 in Bellevue.

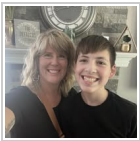
“ I meant Jerry while working for the city, he was a thoughtful and professional employee. We enjoyed his visiting us in Southern Oregon. May his memory be a blessing.
