Francis Hugh Redden, age 82 of Omaha, NE peacefully passed away surrounded by family on Saturday, May 31, 2025 at the Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha.

He was born on April 6, 1943 to John Henry Redden and Iva Nettie (Brooks) Redden in Omaha. He was raised and schooled in Murray, NE. Francis met the love of his life Michelle “Micki” Rae Sutton and they later married on May 25, 1961 in Papillion, NE. Francis and Micki made their home in Plattsmouth, NE for a time and then they later moved to Omaha.
