General "Ted" F. Callier, age 88 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Tuesday, June 25, 2024 at his residence.

Ted was born on July 25, 1935 to General Alfred Callier and Alice Mae (Turner) Callier in Columbus, GA. He was raised and schooled in Columbus and he graduated from Spencer High School with the class of 1953. After graduating from high school, Ted enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and he proudly served his country for twenty-six and a half years. Ted served during the Korean and Vietnam Wars and he retired as a Chief Master Sergeant in July of 1980. After retiring from the U.S. Air Force, Ted worked at Harris Corporation (satellite corps) for fifteen years until he retired in 1995.

Ted had a beloved servant's heart. He was a strong man of God and showed it clearly through his active philanthropy. While living in California he rose to the rank of 32nd Degree Mason. He taught Bible Study Fellowship for four years for First and Second graders. He delivered Meals on Wheels for the Plattsmouth Senior Center for several years. However, Ted's passion was serving actively on the Board of Directors at the Open Door Mission for 35 years.
