George Andrew Johnson, age 80 of Ormond Beach, FL formerly of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Tuesday, April 2, 2024 at Halifax Health Hospice in Ormond Beach.

George was born on May 17, 1943 to Paul Johnson Sr. and Gaynell (Crocker) Johnson in Charlotte, NC. He was raised and schooled in Charlotte and he graduated from West Macklenberg High School with the class of 1961. After graduating from high school, George enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and he proudly served his country during the Vietnam War for over eight years.

George met Diane Estelle Dworak and they were later married on March 6, 1965 at St. Philip Neri Church in Omaha. George and Diane made their home and raised their children in Bellevue, NE and Fort Calhoun, NE. After serving his country, George worked as a postal carrier and he attended and graduated from Bellevue College with Bachelor of Arts degree in Business Administration in 1974. Later George attended and graduated from the University of Bellevue with a Bachelor of Science degree in Management of Human Resources in 1995. In 1997, George and Diane moved to Beaver Lake, NE. George served his country in the U.S. Army Reserves from July of 1987 until May of 2003. While in the reserves he spent a year of active duty in the U.S. Army, retiring as a Master Sergeant. After serving his country, George worked as a postal carrier.

He was a member of and an acolyte at the Church of the Holy Spirit and George was a member of the Knights of Columbus Father Shine Council #1966 both in Plattsmouth.

George is survived by his daughter: Dawn Braun and husband Scott of Omaha, NE; son: David Johnson and wife Jeannie of Sioux Falls, SD; ten grandchildren; five great grandchildren; his brother: Daniel Johnson and his wife Phyllis of Millboro, DE; his sister: Jacki Taylor of Denver, NC; numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and many friends.

He is preceded in death by his parents: Paul Sr. and Gaynell Johnson, his wife: Diane Johnson, his brother: Paul Johnson Jr., and his two sisters: Jane McQuay and Geri Doby.

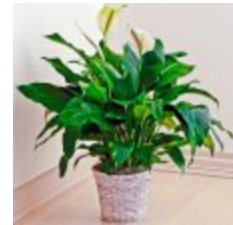
