Georgia Theodora “Teddy” (Mann) Gaukel, age 75 of Omaha, NE peacefully passed away on Thursday, May 21, 2020 at the Hospice House in Omaha. She was born on October 27, 1944 to Robert Marriot and Dorothy Jane (Farmer) Mann in Omaha. Georgia was raised and schooled in Plattsmouth, NE through her junior year, when she transferred and then graduated from South High School in Omaha with the class of 1962. Then she attended and graduated from Brigham Young University in Provo, UT with her degree in education and her minor in Spanish. Georgia returned to Plattsmouth and she worked as a substitute teacher at Conestoga Public Schools and the Omaha Public Schools. In 1983 she began working at Millard Central Middle School as the Spanish Teacher. Georgia taught Spanish at Millard Central until she retired. She made her home in Plattsmouth until 1968 when she moved to La Vista, NE and later Georgia moved to Millard, NE in 1978.

Georgia is survived by her two sons: J.C. Gaukel and wife Angela of Omaha, NE; Stephen Gaukel of Omaha, NE; daughter: Jenny Gaukel of Las Vegas, NV; granddaughter: Madeline “Maddie” Gaukel of Omaha, NE; brother: Charles Hunter-Mann and wife Fran of Savage, MN; numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and many friends.
