Glen Edward Adams age 70 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Tuesday, October 16, 2018 at Nebraska Medicine – Bellevue in Bellevue, NE.

He was born on May 10, 1948 to Glen Willis and Norma Rae (Bacon) Adams in Omaha, NE. He was raised and schooled in north Omaha and graduated from North High School with the class of 1966.
