Glen "Al" Albert Wetenkamp age 72 of Isanti, MN, formerly of Plattsmouth, NE, passed away peacefully on Saturday, March 5, 2016 at Abbott Northwestern Medical Center in Minneapolis, MN.

Al was born on May 6, 1943 to Glenn William and Agnes Edna (Frady) Wetenkamp on his family's farm west of Plattsmouth, NE. He was raised on his family's farm and was baptized and confirmed in the Evangelical United Brethren Church in Mynard, NE, where he and his siblings frequently sang as a quartet. He attended the Little Red Brick School West of Mynard and graduated from Plattsmouth High School with the class of 1961. After graduating from high school, he attended and graduated from Wayne State Teacher College in Wayne, NE with a Bachelor's Degree in Industrial Arts. Al taught drivers education and industrial arts for four years at Oakland Community Schools in Oakland, IA, where he met Rebecca "Becky" Ann Zimmerman. Al and Becky were married on May 17, 1969 at the United Church of Christ in Oakland, IA. After returning to Plattsmouth in 1970, he had worked for Allied Chemical Corporation, Nebraska Tractor, Great Plains Industrial Supply, and RW Lyall & Company before starting his own business, Wetenkamp Utility Sales Inc. There he designed, fabricated, and installed odorization equipment for the natural gas industry throughout the Midwest. Al always had a deep love for farming and ranching. He purchased his first

farm and feedlot from his father-in-law near Walnut, IA and later his family farm west of Mynard. Al enjoyed family camping and fishing trips to the mountains and traveled all over the west.

He served as President of the Midwest National Association of Corrosion Engineers and was a member of the Plattsmouth Masonic Lodge #6 A.F. and A.M.
