Harold J. Payton age 86 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Tuesday, June 3, 2014 at the Golden Living Center in Plattsmouth, NE.

Harold was born on February 10, 1928 to Willard Earl and Effie Ann (Fullerton) Payton in Plattsmouth, NE. He was raised and schooled in Plattsmouth and attended Plattsmouth High School. After high school he enlisted in the US Marines and served his country during WWII. After serving his country, he returned to Plattsmouth and began working for the Union Stock Yards Company of Omaha.
