Harold James Pollard age 92 of Plattsmouth, NE formerly of Nehawka, NE passed away on Wednesday, November 7, 2018 at The Nebraska Masonic Home in Plattsmouth.

He was born on October 8, 1926 to Merritt Fuller and Zola Rae (Frans) Pollard in Nehawka. Harold was raised and schooled in Nehawka. He graduated from Nehawka High School with the class of 1944. Harold enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served his country for a year and a half during WWII. After the war ended, he returned to Nehawka and worked as a farmer. Harold met Betty Jane Samson on a blind date. They married in September of 1952 in Council Bluffs, IA. Harold and Betty made their home and raised their children on the Pollard family farm west of Nehawka. In addition to farming, Harold owned Pollard Soil Service and later Aerial Applicators a crop dusting service. After retiring, Harold kept himself busy working various endeavors and occupations. Due to his failing health Harold moved to The Nebraska Masonic Home in 2013.

He was a member of the Nehawka United Methodist Church, Euclid Masonic Lodge #97 A.F. & A.M. in Weeping Water, and American Legion Post #157 in Nehawka.

Harold is survived by his three sons: Terry Pollard and wife Donna of Jefferson City, MO; Gary Pollard of Nehawka, NE; Thomas Pollard and wife Kelley of Republican City, NE; two daughters: Nancy Vogel and husband Ronald of Omaha, NE; Lesa Jensen and husband Kevin of Littleton, CO; eleven grandchildren; seventeen great grandchildren; sister: Zola Ruth Chieppa of Jupiter, FL; numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

He was preceded in death by parents: Merritt and Zola Pollard, brother: Merritt Pollard Jr., and his wife: Betty Pollard.

A Memorial Service will be held at 4:00 P.M., on Saturday; November 10, 2018 at Nehawka United Methodist Church with Pastor Sandy Webster officiating and Donna Pollard as organist. A Private Masonic Service will be held for the family.
