Harry T. Danner, age 80 of Plattsmouth, NE peacefully passed surrounded by family on Thursday, April 17, 2025 at his residence.

He was born on April 17, 1945, to Ralph David Danner Sr. and Connie Gladys (Moody) Danner in Possum Holler, TN. Harry was raised and schooled in Wilmington, DE. When Harry was seventeen, he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and he proudly served his country for twenty years and two months.
