Herbert DeWayne Freeburg age 84 of Plattsmouth, NE entered into rest on Monday, April 17, 2017 at his daughter's residence in South Sioux City, NE. DeWayne was born on December 26, 1932 to Herbert Anderson and Elthea Gertrude (Mincer) Freeburg in Spencer, IA. DeWayne was raised and schooled in Plattsmouth, NE and attended Plattsmouth High School. He enlisted in the U.S. Army and served his country for two years during the Korean Conflict. He met Nadine Fae White and they were later married on May 2, 1956 at the Sarpy County Court House in Papillion, NE. DeWayne and Nadine made their home and raised their children in Plattsmouth. DeWayne owned and operated the Gamble's Store from 1951 until 1977. Then he worked as a furniture salesman for Townesquare in Dallas, TX from 1977 until he retired in 2000. While DeWayne was working for Townesquare, he was very proud of helping with the design of the "Glider Chair".

He was a charter member of Plattsmouth Fire and Rescue Squad, member of Lepert Wolever V.F.W. Post #2543, and the 4-H Horse Saddle Club all of Plattsmouth.
