Janis Aileen (Trabert) Eno age 90 of Plattsmouth, NE formerly of Lincoln, NE, peacefully passed away on Friday, December 2, 2022 at The Nebraska Masonic Home in Plattsmouth.

She was born on September 4, 1932 to Neil Sterling Trabert Sr. and Aileen Dak (Wright) Trabert in Hastings, NE. Janis was raised and attended school in Lincoln at Saratoga Elementary, Irving Jr. High, and Lincoln High School. She attended the University of Nebraska at Lincoln for two years before marrying Gene Leroy Eno on August 23, 1952 at First Presbyterian Church in Lincoln. Janis and Gene made their home and raised their seven children in Lincoln. She worked as a Cartographer for the Nebraska Department of Roads, where she made county and state maps. Then Janis worked as a Lab Technician for the USDA Soil Conservation Service Lab in Lincoln until she retired.

Janis was a longtime member of First Presbyterian Church in Lincoln. She was active in the music program, women's circles, sewing group, and she was an Elder/Deacon. Janis also played the organ for the Lincoln Latvian Church for several years.

She is survived by her five children: Sally (Billie) L. Plants, John W. Eno, Karen A. Meyer, Tom L. Eno, and Todd A. Eno, nine grandchildren, three great grandchildren, and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
