Jeffrey Marc "Jeff" Cloidt age 61 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Wednesday, May 17, 2017 at his home.

Jeff was born on September 13, 1955 to John Joseph Jr. and Winifred Hazel (Evans) Cloidt in Omaha, NE. Jeff was raised and attended school in Plattsmouth, graduating from Plattsmouth High School in 1973. He moved to Lincoln, where he attended the University of Nebraska at Lincoln, but he soon made a reputation for himself as a drummer with such bands as Pinky Black and the Excessives, Lightning Blues, and Roadside Attraction. Jeff was in demand and very active in the Lincoln music scene for some years. He was married to the former Suzy Theis, though they later divorced. After living for a while in Hawaii, Jeff moved back to Plattsmouth, where he has been caretaker for his mother for the last fifteen years.

Jeff loved music, photography, and movies, and was interested in politics and pop culture. He was an animal lover and had a series of cats and dogs which he doted on throughout his life. Jeff was an extremely kind and sensitive person, but he also had a sharp wit and a sardonic, and occasionally surreal, sense of humor. He was much loved by his family and friends and he will be greatly missed.

He is survived by his mother: Winifred Cloidt of Plattsmouth, NE; his siblings: Monica Vance of Lincoln, NE; Jay Cloidt of Oakland, CA; numerous cousins

from the Ulrich and Chovanec families; and his friends. He is preceded in death by his father, John Cloidt Jr.
