Jerome “Jerry” William Painter age 65 of Plattsmouth, NE peacefully passed away on Wednesday, November 10, 2021 at the Bellevue Medical Center in Bellevue, NE.

Jerry was born on July 27, 1956 to Charles Robert and Bonnie L. (Letourneau) Painter in Omaha, NE. He was raised and schooled in Plattsmouth and he graduated from Plattsmouth High School with the class of 1974. Jerry started working when he was sixteen years old at Ruback’s Grocery Store in Plattsmouth. After he graduated from high school, Jerry continued working at Ruback’s but he also worked at the Village Nursery and Grove’s Jewelry.
