John Richard Dolly age 87 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Thursday, December 23, 2021 at the Bellevue Medical Center in Bellevue, NE.

John was born on April 7, 1934 to John and Mary (Curran) Dolly in Omaha, NE. He was raised and schooled in Omaha and he graduated from Technical High School with the class of 1952. After graduating from high school, John enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and he proudly served his country for four years during the Korean War from 1952 until 1956. After serving his country, John and his brother owned and operated the A&W Root Beer Stand in Fort Madison, IA. In the early 70's he returned to Omaha. John met the love of his life, Marilyn Irene Warga at a swim meet in high school and they later married on June 9, 1973 in Plattsmouth. John and Marilyn made their home in Plattsmouth and John managed the Plattsmouth Country Club until it closed in the early 90's.
