LaVane Louise (Vogltance) Heimann age 75 of Elkhorn, NE formerly of Howells, NE passed away peacefully on Tuesday, April 28, 2015 surrounded by her loving family after a lengthy battle with Neuroendocrine Cancer at the Josie Harper Hospice House in Omaha, NE.

LaVane was born on November 13, 1939 to Pete Frank and Vlasta Leona (Mestl) Vogltance in Dodge, NE. She was raised in Dodge, attended St. Wenceslaus Grade School, and graduated from Dodge High School with the class of 1957. After graduating from high school, LaVane moved to Omaha, NE where she attended business school and worked at Farmers Union Grain Exchange. She met the love of her life, Kenneth Francis Heimann and they were later united in marriage on November 4, 1958 at St. Wenceslaus Catholic Church in Dodge.
