Lloyd Edwin Coffelt Jr. age 77 of Bellevue, NE passed away peacefully on Thursday, October 10, 2024 at Hillcrest Shadow Lake in Papillion, NE. He was born on June 26, 1947 to Lloyd Edwin Coffelt Sr. and Virginia Delma (Rose) Coffelt in Omaha, NE. He was raised and schooled in Omaha and Lloyd graduated from Central High School with the class of 1965. After high school, Lloyd worked in the Commissary at Offutt Air Force Base in Bellevue, NE. He met the love of his life, Linda Lou Leitow and they were later married on February 14, 1971 at Zion Lutheran Church in rural Bancroft, NE. Lloyd and Linda made the home and raised their sons in Omaha, except from 1978 until 1983 when they lived in Mesa, AZ while Lloyd worked for RGIS, an inventory company. After living in Mesa, Lloyd worked for the U.S. Postal Service in Omaha until he retired early at the age of 63.

Lloyd is survived by his son: Timothy “Tim” Coffelt and wife Brandy of Bellevue, NE, two grandchildren: Joshua Coffelt and his wife Piper of Omaha, NE and Heather Coffelt of Omaha, NE; his sister-in-law: Mary Snyder and her husband Charlie of Omaha, NE; numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and many friends.
