Lois Jean (Gulley) Clark Age 79 of Plattsmouth, Nebraska passed away on Monday, September 9, 2013 at the Nebraska Masonic Home in Plattsmouth, Nebraska.

She was born on January 30, 1934 to Dana Isaac and Mary Victoria (Grigsby) Gulley in Morocco, Indiana.

Lois was raised and schooled in Morocco, Indiana. She graduated from Morocco High School with the class of 1952. After high school, Lois attended and graduated from Nurses Training School as a Registered Nurse. Lois met her future husband, Thomas A. Clark, as a child at their parent's church when they were 2 - 4 years old and they were later married on March 17, 1956 in Morocco, Indiana. She worked as a Registered Nurse in Indianapolis and Terre Haute, Indiana from 1956 - 1960 and then in Washington DC for twenty months. Lois and Tom moved to Honolulu, Hawaii. She volunteered and later worked at the Hawaiian Medical Reference Library as a Medical Librarian for several years. Then she worked as a Librarian at Kaiser Hospital in the Medical Reference Library. Lois and Tom moved back to Nebraska in 1981 and lived in Bellevue, where Tom was employed at Offutt Air Force Base. Lois volunteered at the Bellevue Library and eventually worked there part time for 2-3 years. She was a homemaker and wife. She moved to the Nebraska Masonic Home in Plattsmouth, Nebraska in 2002.

She is a life member and Past Matron (1972) of Order of Eastern Star Leahi Chapter #2 of Honolulu, Hawaii and a member of Order of Eastern Star Home Chapter #189 of Plattsmouth, Nebraska.

Lois is survived by her Husband: Thomas Clark of Plattsmouth, NE, Three Nieces and numerous Cousins and Friends.

She was preceded in death by her Parents: Dana and Mary Gulley, and Five Brothers: Dana Jackson Gulley, Julian Gulley, Paul Gulley, Earl Gulley, and Willard Gulley. Lois was the last of her immediate family.
