Mary Jane (Upthegrove) Scott age 81 passed away Saturday, March 17, 2018 in Plattsmouth, NE surrounded by her loving and devoted family.

Jane was born in 1936 in the Territory of Hawaii into a military family. Her parents were Maj. Gen. I Fay R. and Marcella G. (Driscoll) Upthegrove, USAF Ret. As a military brat she followed her father around to his assignments all over the United States during his service in the growing Army Air Corps. After World War Two, Jane lived in post war Germany and Okinawa, where she graduated from Kubasaki High School in 1954. She then joined her sister Sue in Washington, DC, where Jane attended Immaculata Junior College, graduating in 1956. Moving to Gautier, Mississippi, she met and married 2nd Lieutenant Richard Scott on 5 September 1959. Her travels with her growing family led her back to Okinawa and Germany in the 1960s & 1970s. Jane and Scotty finally settled down in Plattsmouth.

Jane was a gifted artist, avid gardener, gourmet cook and life-long crafter, her most recent passion being primitive rug-hooking.

She is survived by husband LtCol. Richard "Scotty" Scott, USAF Ret, of Plattsmouth, NE, her sister Sue (Lt Col. Lawrence USAF Retired) Kinch; 3 sons SGM Patrick (Roxy North) Scott, USA Ret, Jon (Jane) Scott and CPT Chris (Sherry) Scott, USAR Ret; daughter Molly (Kevin Spier) Scott; 4 grandchildren Sarah, Katie, Andy, and Jack; her extended Air Force family;
