Meredith B. (Bierman) Hansen, age 82 of Plattsmouth, NE, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, October, 7, 2025.

Meredith was born on April 25, 1943, to Haley Campfield Bierman and Esther Maude (Pitchford) Bierman in Beaumont, TX. She grew up in Texarkana, TX, and graduated from Texas Senior High School with the Class of 1961.

Meredith lived in North Carolina before moving to Bellevue, NE and then settling in Plattsmouth, NE. She met the love of her life, Craig Barlow Hansen, and they were later married on December 23, 1989, in Mesquite, TX.

She worked at Nebraska Medicine in the Anatomy and Intellectual Property departments in Omaha, NE for thirty years. After leaving UNMC Meredith worked part-time at the Creighton Medical Center in the Osteoporosis Research Lab, Pamida, the Cass County Courthouse in the Probation Office and the Dollar General in Plattsmouth.

Meredith was a devoted wife, loving mother, and caring grandmother. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Plattsmouth and she had been active in various community organizations.

She is survived by her step children, grandchildren and many friends. She was preceded in death by her parents Haley and Esther Bierman and her beloved husband Craig Hansen.

A Memorial Service will be held at 11:00 A.M., on November 29, 2025 at the First United Methodist Church in Plattsmouth, NE with Rev. Lee Wigert officiating.
