Michael Lee Lewis age 80 of Omaha, NE passed away on Saturday, March 31, 2018 at his residence.

Mike was born on November 30, 1937 to Orville Monroe and Ermal Alice (Erwin) Lewis in Nebraska City, NE. He lived in California with his family until age seven, when they moved to Plattsmouth, NE.
