Milo DeWitt Perry, Jr. age 89 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away peacefully on Tuesday, November 25, 2014 at the Nebraska Masonic Home in Plattsmouth. Milo was born on July 6, 1925 to Milo DeWitt Sr. and Freda (Dietz) Perry in Norfolk, NE. He was raised and schooled in Norfolk and he graduated from Norfolk High School with the class of 1943. After graduating from high school, he enlisted in the US Navy, serving during WWII in the Pacific Theatre for three years. Milo married the love of his life LaVerne Mae Kellner on August 29, 1948 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Norfolk. He attended the University of Nebraska at Lincoln, Norfolk Junior College, and graduated from St. Louis School of Mortuary Science in St. Louis, MO. He completed his mortuary science internship at John A. Gentleman Mortuary in Omaha, NE. Then Milo worked for Crosby Kunold Funeral Home in Omaha and later for Bader Funeral Home in Fremont, NE. In 1964, Milo purchased Sattler Funeral Home in Plattsmouth. He and John Fusselman operated Fusselman Perry Funeral Homes in Plattsmouth, Louisville, and Syracuse, NE. Milo retired 1982, and then in 1986 Milo and LaVerne moved to Belle Vista, AR where they enjoyed their retirement years. In 2008 they moved to Bellevue, NE and in 2013 to the Nebraska Masonic Home in Plattsmouth.

Milo was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Plattsmouth Masonic Lodge #6 A.F. and A.M., Order of Eastern Star Home Chapter #189, Hugh J. Kerns

American Legion Post #56, Lepert Wolever V.F.W. Post #2543, and 40 & 8 Voiture #1218 all of Plattsmouth. Milo was a former member of Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie #365 and Plattsmouth Lions Club both of Plattsmouth.
