Norman “Norm” Eugene Manley age 83 of Murray, NE peacefully passed away surrounded by his family on Saturday, February 3, 2024 at his residence.

Norman was born in Elk Creek, NE on December 7, 1940 to Warren Clifford Manley and Sarah Alice (Edwards) Manley. Shortly afterwards they moved to Burchard, NE until he was ten years old, when they moved to Beatrice, NE and two years later the family moved to Omaha, NE. He passed peacefully at home surrounded by family with love and prayers.

Norm was a hard worker both on the field and at his job. He played basketball and softball on the M.U.D. team. He later found his love of golf and enjoyed playing with his brothers and sister, and nephews, who always attempt to win the game. They had to wait until he was eighty to beat him.

He taught his own kids to roof, and other building skills at a young age. Many who built their own homes. And his two daughters who also share a love of home improvement.

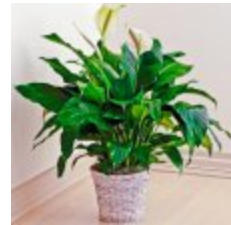
