Patrick John O'Shea Sr. Age 78 of Bellevue, NE passed away on Thursday, November 21, 2013 at Douglas County Health Center in Omaha, NE.

He was born on December 17, 1934 to Timothy Patrick and Alice Julia (Bardon) O'Shea in Egg Harbor City, NJ. He was raised and schooled in Egg Harbor City and graduated from Egg Harbor City High School. After high school he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force in 1953. While serving in the Air Force he met the love of his life, Estelle Marie Long and they later married on January 31, 1955 in Sacramento, CA. Patrick and Estelle made their home and raised their children in several different locations while he served in the Air Force, finally settling in Bellevue, NE in 1970. He was awarded the Bronze Star Medal and later retired from the Air Force in 1973, after served his country during the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War. After retiring from the Air Force, he worked as a Postal Carrier for the US Postal Service for twenty years, retiring in 1997.

Patrick was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Bellevue, NE.
