Paul Allen Steube Jr. age 83 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away peacefully on Monday, May 11, 2015, surrounded by family at the Josie Harper Hospice House in Omaha, NE.

He was born on April 15, 1932 to Paul Allen Sr. and Thelma Roselle (Voyles) Steube in York, NE. He was raised in York and then moved to Auburn, NE where he graduated from Auburn High School with the class of 1950. He met Sally Tress Gaines and they were married on September 4, 1954 in Plattsmouth.
