Raymond John Kriskey age 87 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Saturday, August 21, 2021 at the Hillcrest Country Cottages Long Term Care in Papillion, NE.

John was born on December 14, 1933 to Raymond Theodore and Marjorie Alice (Denson) Kriskey in Plattsmouth. He was raised and schooled in Plattsmouth and John graduated from Plattsmouth High School with the class of 1951. He enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and John proudly served his country for four years during the Korean War. After serving his country, John attended the University of Nebraska at Lincoln. John met Marcia Mae Matthews, they were married on June 24, 1961 in Omaha, NE and they recently celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary.
