It is with great sadness that we inform you of the passing of Richard Everett Newton, who passed away on Friday, July 12, 2024, at his home in Bellevue, NE.

Richard was born on September 7, 1944, in Hastings, Nebraska. He grew up in Plattsmouth Nebraska and graduated from Plattsmouth High School in 1963. After completing high school, Richard pursued two and a half years of studies in the medical technician field at the University of Nebraska at Lincoln. He then moved to Omaha in 1965 and dedicated 35 years of his professional life to the University of Nebraska Medical Center, which included Clarkson Hospital and the Eppley Cancer Institution. In 2018, Richard relocated to Bellevue NE, and became affiliated with Bellevue University.

Richard was well-known for his friendly nature and his ability to engage in thought-provoking conversations. His willingness to share a meal and a tale made him beloved by all who had the pleasure of interacting with him. His presence will be greatly missed by everyone who knew him.

He is survived by his close friend Daniel “Dan” Bennett and his wife Sherry from Omaha, NE. Additionally, he is remembered by numerous friends and colleagues.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Everett and Delta (Day) Newton, and his only sibling, Joyce Elaine Newton.

A Graveside Service will be held at 10:00 A.M., on Thursday, July 18, 2024 at Oak Hill Cemetery in Plattsmouth.
