Richard Glenn Riggs age 94 of Bellevue, NE peacefully passed away on Sunday, January 22, 2023 at the Eastern Nebraska Veterans Home in Bellevue.

He was born on January 20, 1929 to Glenn Forest Riggs and Marguerite Fern (Gallimore) Riggs in Richmond, IN. He was raised and schooled in Connersville, IN and he graduated from Connersville High School. After graduating from high school, Richard enlisted in the U.S. Army and he proudly served his country during the Korean War. After serving his country, Richard owned and operated a retail paint and wallpaper business from 1950 until 1986 when Richard retired. He continued to work part-time for the next fourteen years. Richard had lived in Xenia, OH, Birmingham, AL, Connersville, IN, Plattsmouth, NE, and Bellevue, NE.

He is survived by his son: Richard Michael Riggs and his wife Tammy of Kinder, LA; two daughters: Elizabeth “Betsy” Haefele and her husband Mark of Plattsmouth, NE; Barbara Dimmick of Hellertown, PA; nine grandchildren; eleven great grandchildren; and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

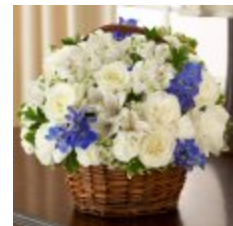
