Robert "Bob" Erwin Ray age 79 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Thursday, August 11, 2016 at the Golden Living Center in Plattsmouth.

He was born on August 7, 1937 to William H. and Adele M. (Barnett) Ray in Rumney, NH. Bob was raised and schooled in Plymouth, NH and graduated from Plymouth High School with the class of 1955. After graduating from high school, he worked various jobs and he joined the New Hampshire National Guard. He met Janice Marie Boisvert and they were later married in 1959 in Plymouth, NH. Bob secured a position at New Hampshire Electric Coop, until he retired in 1999. Bob and Janice made their home Plymouth until 2006, when they moved to Plattsmouth, NE after retiring to be near their children.

Bob was especially fond of music. He was well known as the lead singer and guitarist of the country western band, Bob Ray and the Country Travelers.
