Robert "Bob" Junior Piper age 75 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Monday, February 12, 2018 at his residence.

He was born on December 3, 1942 to Robert Christopher and Madeline Lenore (Record) Piper in Plattsmouth. Bob was raised and schooled in Plattsmouth and he graduated from Plattsmouth High School with the class of 1961. After graduating from high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and served his country for two years during the Vietnam War from 1961 until 1963. He met Sharon Fay Wichman and they were later married on October 8, 1966 at First United Methodist Church in Plattsmouth. Bob and Sharon made their home and raised their children in Plattsmouth. He worked as a carpenter for the Carpenters Local Union #253 in the greater Omaha, NE area for fifty years.

Bob was member of First United Methodist Church, Plattsmouth Masonic Lodge #6 A.F. and A.M. (Past Master 1986), Knights of The York Cross of Honor, Order of Eastern Star Home Chapter #189, Jobs Daughters Bethel #24 (Past Guardian), and he was a York Rite, Knights Templar all of Plattsmouth.
