Roy Dale Edmonds, age 90 years, 9 months, and 8 days of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Thursday, March 25, 2021 at Hillcrest Health & Rehab in Bellevue, NE.

He was born, the oldest of six children, on June 17, 1930 to Elijah Buell and Lulu Loretta (Severs) Edmonds on his family's farm in rural Nehawka, NE. Roy was raised and schooled in Auburn, NE. When Roy was fourteen years old he left home to work as a farm hand, harvesting potatoes in western Nebraska for silver dollars. He joined U.S. Army on March 10, 1951. Roy proudly served his country during the Korean War with 2nd INF DIV. 3rd BN 23RD INF. REG. HO CO. Roy married Rose Ilene Jeanneret on December 11, 1955 at the Coryell Chapel in Brock, NE. Roy and Rose made their home and raised their children in Plattsmouth area for the past 65 years.

Roy was a member of First Christian Church in Plattsmouth, Plattsmouth Masonic Lodge #6 A.F. and A.M. for 65 years, Scottish Rite, York Rite, Shriners, Order of Eastern Star Home Chapter #189, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, Lepert Wolever V.F.W. Post #2543, and the Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie #365. He had been PTA president at Wintersteen School, and Boy Scout leader for many years.

He is survived by his wife: Rose, five children and spouses, 14 grandchildren, 44 great grandchildren, sister: Betty Toth, brother: Paul Edmonds, and many

other family and friends.

Roy was preceded in death by his parents: Elijah and Lulu Edmonds, three siblings: Mildred (Edmonds) Wilber, Lloyd Edmonds, and Elijah Edmonds, and his son: Randal Edmonds.
