Savannah Naomi Robertson Age 17 of Beaver Lake, NE passed away at the Nebraska Medical Center on Monday, December 23, 2013 in Omaha, NE.

She was born on August 31, 1996 to Phillip Lee II and Rebecca Naomi (Wiles) Robertson in Fort Hood, Texas. She was raised and schooled in Savannah, GA, Oahu, HI, Fort Polk, LA, Fort Lewis, WA, Anchorage, AK, Nebraska City, Weeping Water, Murray, and Beaver Lake, NE. Savannah was freshman at Nebraska City High School, a sophomore and junior at Weeping Water High School, and currently was a senior at Conestoga High School in rural Murray, NE. She worked for Real Princesses in Omaha, NE where she portrayed "Ariel" from Disney's The Little Mermaid. She was an avid dancer, singer, and actress. She loved spending time with children, her family, and friends. Savannah was a member of the Weeping Water Rockettes, Track Team, Volleyball Team, Basketball Team, All School Musical, One Act Play Production, and the Big Pal Program all at Weeping Water High School in Weeping Water, NE. She was a member of the Cougarettes Dance Team, One Act Play Production, and the Speech Team at Conestoga High School in Murray, NE.
