Susan “Sue” Joan (Watson) Zweibahmer, age 73 of Plattsmouth, NE entered into eternal rest on Monday, February 19, 2024, at CHI Health Midlands Community Hospital in Papillion, NE.

She was born on February 9, 1951, to George Newton Watson and Patricia Joan (Hewitt) Watson in Paris, IL. She was raised and schooled in several locations as her father was serving his country in the U.S. Air Force. Sue graduated from Madrid High School in Madrid, Spain. She met the love of her life Steven “Steve” Albert Zweibahmer, while he was stationed at Torrejón Air Force Base, Madrid, Spain where he was serving in the U.S Air Force. They were later married on October 18, 1969, at St. Aloysius Catholic Church in Calmar, IA. 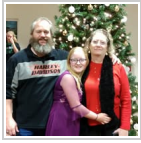
