Sylvia Marie (Moore) Ballinger, age 98 of Sedalia, MO passed away peacefully on Wednesday, December 16, 2021 at her residence by the side of her son Roger and granddaughter Kimberly.

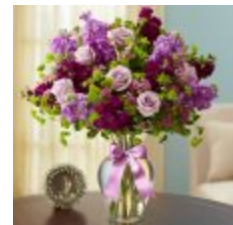
