Thomas Allen Clark age 85 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Thursday, July 18, 2019 at The Nebraska Masonic Home in Plattsmouth.

He was born on November 4, 1933 to Clifford Morden and Carrie Elizabeth (Sharp) Clark on a farm near Morocco, IN. Thomas met Lois Jean Gulley and they were married on March 17, 1956 in Morocco. They were married for 57 years when Lois passed away in 2013.

After serving in the United State Air Force as a security policeman, Thomas attended Indiana State Teacher's College and graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Language Arts and Mathematics in 1959. Thomas also received a Master of Science Degree in Systems Management from the University of South Southern California in 1979.

Thomas worked for over thirty as a computer systems analyst and spent the majority of time working with military computer systems. He worked for two years in Washington DC and 18 years in Hawaii. Later in his career he was transferred with MITRE Corporation to Omaha and spent over 10 years supporting the Strategic Air Command.

He was member of Pearl Harbor Masonic Lodge #598 F. & A.M. in Honolulu, HI and served as Worshipful Master in 1977. In 1989, he became a dual member with Plattsmouth Masonic Lodge #6 A.F. and A.M. in Plattsmouth, NE. He was also a member of Nebraska Chapter #3, Royal Arch Masons

Thomas is survived by his sister: Evelyn Dixon and husband John of Overland Park, KS; his niece: Rebecca Oldham and husband Bill of Simpsonville, SC; his nephew: Timothy Clark of Huntsville, AL; great niece: Madison Oldham; great nephew: William Oldham; and numerous cousins and friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents: Clifford and Carrie Clark, wife: Lois Clark, brother: Kenneth Clark, and his sister: Rosalie Haste.
