Twila Sue (Pease) Stuhr of Plattsmouth, NE triumphantly entered God's heavenly home on Tuesday, September 30 after a long battle with breast cancer.

Twila was born on February 13, 1953 to Billy Lee and Lillian Frances (Mantzey) Pease in Maryville, MO. She married Lloyd Stuhr on July 12, 1974. Among Twila's life accomplishments is her graduation from Bryan School of nursing in 1974, 15 years of services as a Registered Nurse in general medicine and psychiatric medicine and 17 years in hospice nursing. She also served as an RN on several short-term medical mission trips to Haiti. She was most recently recognized as a Worthy Woman of Distinction by Suburban Newspapers.

She was an active member at Wedgewood Christian Church, Lincoln, St. John's Lutheran Church Madison, MN, Pilgrim Lutheran Church in Bellevue, NE, St. Luke Lutheran Church, Ann Arbor, MI, Olivette Lutheran, St. Louis, MO and First Lutheran Church in Plattsmouth, NE where her husband is currently Pastor.
