Vicky Eileen (Spittler) Nickeson, age 57 of Plattsmouth, Nebraska passed away on July 25, 2013 at the Josie Harper Hospice House in Omaha, Nebraska.

Vicky was born on October 29, 1955 in Norfolk, Nebraska to Jerome Arthur and Eileen Lorraine (Kelly) Spittler, but she was raised and schooled in O'Neill, Nebraska. Vicky attended and graduated from St. Mary's High School in O'Neill, Nebraska with the class of 1974. After high school, she studied court reporting at the A.I.B. College of Business in Des Moines, Iowa for 2 years. Vicky and Randy knew each other in high school, but did not start dating until they were both in college and they later married on October 8, 1983 in O'Neill, Nebraska. After college she moved to Plattsmouth and worked for Judge Raymond "Joe" Case. One for the most important and profound decisions she and Randy made together, was for her to be a stay at home mom and raise their children. She later returned to work for Judge Randall Rehmeier.

She was a member of the Nebraska Court Reporters Association.
