Wayne “Bud” Leon Lewis age 82 of Plattsmouth, NE passed away on Monday, November 28, 2022 at The Nebraska Masonic Home in Plattsmouth.

Wayne was born on July 27, 1940, to Ethan Wayne Lewis and Emma Dora (Lange) Lewis in Mynard. He attended Jean Country School and graduated from Plattsmouth High with the class of 1959. Wayne “Bud” Leon Lewis and Linda Rose Ränge married on September 1, 1961, in Mynard, NE. Bud and Linda made their home and raised their children on the Ränge family farm. Bud worked at NPPD, Conestoga Public Schools and Plattsmouth Public Schools. Bud enjoyed entertaining and was part of a local country band for over 30 years.

He was a volunteer on the Murray Fire and Rescue team for many years. He was a longtime member of Hugh J. Kerns American Legion Post #56, Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie #365 and the Plattsmouth Masonic Lodge #6 A.F. and A.M.
