William "Bill" Lester Lockhart age 88 of Omaha, NE formerly of Plattsmouth, NE peacefully passed away on Thursday, May 5, 2016 at Bergan Mercy Medical Center in Omaha.

Bill was born on January 13, 1928 to Garland R. and Frances Eugena (Lester) Lockhart in Nebraska City, NE. He was raised and schooled in Plattsmouth, NE and graduated from Plattsmouth High School. He enlisted in the US Army and served his country during WWII. After serving his country, he worked on various construction jobs. He met Imogene "Jean" Howard and they were later married on July 12, 1952 in Glenwood, IA. Bill and Jean made their home in Plattsmouth and later in Omaha, where they raised their children. Bill worked in Omaha as an electrician for thirty one years at Western Electric and later at AT&T, until he retired on November 22, 2003.
